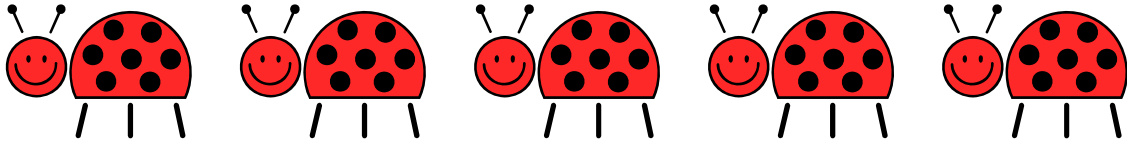


Kindergarten Supply List 2009-2010

Please bring the following supplies to our **Meet and Greet on – August 15, 2008**. You can drop off supplies anytime from 6:00 – 7:00pm. Please keep backpacks and lunchboxes until the first day of school.

- 2 large **ELMER'S** Washable Glue Sticks
- 2 packs of 24 **CRAYOLA** crayons – 2 separate packs not one large pack
- 1 pack of multi-colored construction paper
- 1 pack of pencil erasers
- 1-12 pack of plain yellow #2 pencils
- 1 pump bottle of hand sanitizer
